Have you been reunited with your young child after a foster care placement?

You may be eligible for free services in a voluntary research study!

Who can join?

- **If you have a trial return home with a child from age 1 year up to 4 years**
- **You live in the study area (King, northern Pierce, and southern Snohomish counties)**
- **You are able to speak English**
- **You have access to a phone**

What would I get?

- **1 of 2 free services: (1) A phone program to help parents find help in their community or (2) An in-home program to help parents with young children.**
- **UW research visits in your home. These visits include videotaping you and your child playing, doing some activities, and an interview.**
- **Payment of \$75 for each of 3 in-home research visits (\$225 total).**
- **A chance to ask questions or get help. Our staff works with you.**
